- Buchanan School is a vibrant K-6 community that embodies the rich tapestry of our diverse neighborhood. With one class at each grade level, our small size fosters close-knit relationships among students and staff, ensuring that every child feels seen and supported.
- Our fall 2024 demographic data represents a highly diverse student population with 52 % of our students identified as English as an Additional Language learners, 9.6% of students self-identifying as Indigenous, and 24% of our students having identified Special Education requirements. We respect diversity by being intentional in our approach in creating safe, caring and welcoming learning environment where all students can thrive in their learning.
- Buchanan has a strong foundation of students who view themselves positively as learners, however, we recognize the need for continued growth.
- Our SDP goal is that students' achievement in literacy will improve. We will focus on two outcomes:
 - o Students' written communication will improve through formative assessment
 - o Students' achievement in literacy will improve through the implementation of Culturally Relevant and Responsive pedagogies.
